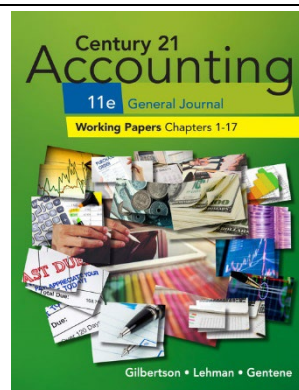
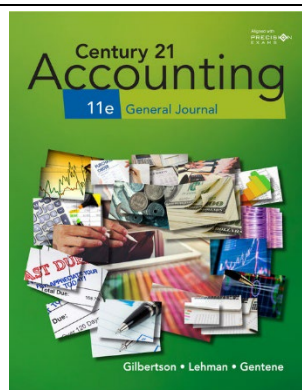


Accounting 1 Night Classes

Ventura Adult and Continuing Education (VACE)

The Accounting class teaches the basics of accounting, including the entire accounting cycle, preparing financial statements, and formal bank reconciliations. Students will need a **Windows-based computer (not a Mac)** with Internet capabilities and be willing to study and complete homework every day.

This **In-Person Night Class** requires 30 hours (approximately three hours per week for ten weeks). If you are able to devote more time weekly, you can complete the course even sooner.

Each lesson consists of instructional videos, related work assignments, and a final exam based on the concepts and principles covered in the book. Learners complete activities in class and at their own pace at home, submitting their work to the instructor. The instructor will grade the assignments and tests and provide feedback in person during class as needed.

Textbook and working papers for the Accounting class are required.
